 - Fee tracking changes
 - added search: by team and by entry
 - fee tracking now works with invoices

What is the difference between a configuration “Manager” and the configuration “Editors”? We are here to set the record straight so you can understand how to use them to their fullest.

- **Managers** create different functions on your site, and give you an area to manage these new functions.
- **Editors** are for adding or editing content on your site or in emails.

In example, if you want to create a new page, find the page **manager**. If you want to add content to your homepage, find the main page content **editor**.
